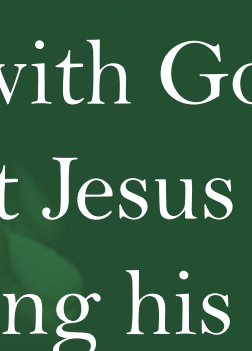
Whether we are alone or with family? What choices are you making? What sacrifices are you making or will make to ensure everyone is doing ok?

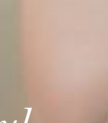

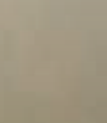
